Why a Coaching Office?

What	How it Helps
Just-in-Time Coaching for those who need it	Serve more teens; especially those who may only wish to or need to have a couple sessions.
Teens can try coaching before they sign up for their own coach	Less teen churn; cut program coordination expenses
Increase the VC to students-coached ratio, e.g. from 1:1 to 1:5 or more.	Better pay off for the high cost of training and on-going support. More effective use of those volunteers we do train, possibly enabling us to even provide a higher level of training.
More effective integration into the school and its culture	

Who is the Coaching Office for?

The office will be for teens who:

- Would like to try coaching before they sign up for a regular on-going 1:1 personal coach
- Do not have a 1:1 coach, yet have a pressing coaching issue and would like a coach to help them see choices and regain their focus
- Have something going on that can be addressed in 1-3 sessions (if they have more than 2-3 Coaching Office appointments, we will suggest that they sign up for their own 1:1 coach)
- Has a Personal Success Coach who is staffing the office at a time that is mutually convenient.

Open for Business: We plan to initially staff the office:

Logistics:

- A school aide or TPC volunteer will be there to manage the appointment calendar.
